- **HOME TEAM** IS LISTED FIRST AND SHOULD WEAR LIGHT UNIFORMS, **VISITING TEAM** LISTED SECOND AND SHOULD WEAR DARK UNIFORM.
- **HOME TEAM** IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE CLOCK OPERATOR, **VISITING TEAM** IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE BOOKKEEPER. This person must be a minimum age of 18.

TOURNAMENT RULES

National Federation of High School Sports rules apply w/ the following exceptions:

- 20 minute running clock except for last two minutes of each half, unless a team is ahead by 15 points and the clock will continue to run. The lead must be below 15 points in order for the clock to stop under two minutes.
- Clock will stop on all timeouts, technical fouls, injuries or officials timeout.
- Official men's basketball will be used for all boys divisions and women's (28.5) will be used for all girls divisions.
- Each team will be allowed a 5 minute warm up prior to the game and at halftime. **NO DUNKING DURING WARM UPS.** TECHNICAL FOULS will be assessed.
- Teams must provide their own balls for warm up and games.
- Overtime will be TWO MINUTES with a STOP CLOCK on all whistles.
- Players may only play in ONE AGE GROUP for the tournament. Violation will result in a forfeit of the second division the player participated in.
- Two technical fouls will result in the player / coach being ejected and subject to permanent removal from the tournament based on the nature of the offense.
- The tournament director(s) may remove FANS / PARENTS from the gym for inappropriate behavior / conduct. **TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE for their FANS BEHAVIOR.**
- **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGES PERMITTED IN THE FACILITY, only EXCEPTION is for PLAYERS WITH WATER / GATORADE.**

TIE BREAKER SYSTEM

If there is a tie between two or more teams after pool play is completed, the following procedure will be used to determine which team (s) advances.

If two teams are tied, teams for first or second place (have identical won-loss records), the winner of their head to head competition advances. If three or more teams are tied, teams in excess of two will be eliminated using a cumulative point differential system as follows:

- Teams will receive up to a maximum of thirteen (13) plus or minus points related to the winning or losing margin of each of their games.
- Plus or minus points are awarded based on point spread in a game.

EXAMPLE:

- If a team wins by 20 points, they receive (+13) points and the losing team receives a (-13). If a team wins by 6 points, they receive a (+6) and the losing teams receives a (-6). A forfeit will be considered a 13 to 0 score. The winner of the head to head competition between the remaining two teams will then advance.
- In the rare situation where the tied teams (in excess of two) have the same total cumulative points, a coin toss will be held by the tournament director to determine which team advances. Head to head competition will not be considered in this situation.

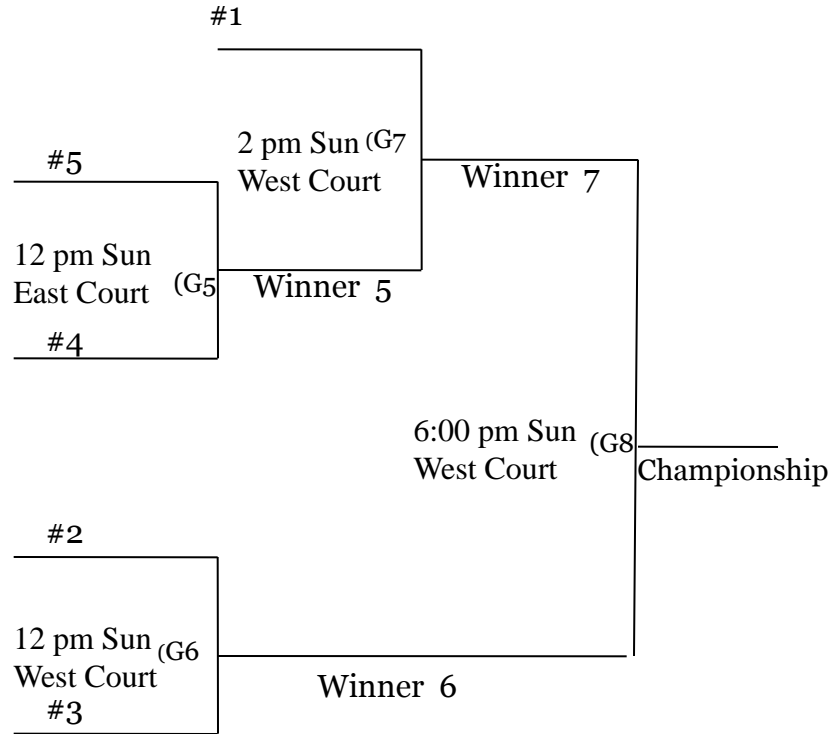
