Dear Coach:

The Edmond Basketball Bonanza will be held July 24 – July 26, 2009 and we are very appreciative of your participation in the tournament. **The Oklahoman, Kirkpatrick Bank of Edmond, and the Edmond Convention & Visitor's Bureau** are the sponsors for this year's event. All of the gate workers and clock keepers will be Edmond parent and player volunteers and they will be available to work at each game so your parents can enjoy watching their teams compete.

We ask that no outside food and drink be brought into the gym and this includes coaches. Players may bring their personal water bottles. Our booster clubs will be operating concession stands and the prices will be very reasonable. We also ask that coaches help cleanup around the bench area after each game. All of the gyms are air-conditioned and the floors have just been refinished so please help us keep the gyms clean. **If you are scheduled to play at North High School gym #2, the gym is located on the north side of the building and you will enter the gym from the NW corner. A school district map is also included in your packet.**

As you review the game schedules please understand that we tried to accommodate your special request. It is also possible that as the tournament enters bracket play, teams may be required to play back-to-back games. If you find a critical scheduling error that would prohibit your team from receiving the 5-game guarantee please contact Mr. Eric Sailer at 405-535-7030 (cell) or David Fraser at 405-340-2816 (w), 550-0023 (cell) david.fraser@edmondschools.net.

Coaches will pick up a packet at the gym where they play their first game. Each team will be provided with two coaches passes. Weekend tournament passes for adults will be sold for \$12 on Friday evening only. Day passes will be sold to adults at a cost of \$5 per day. All fans must have an "Edmond MAYB" stamp before they can re-enter. Boys and girls t-shirts will be on sale for \$10 each or 2 for \$16. The shirts are custom designed for this tournament and I think the players will like the look.

On a final note, MAYB has a list of hotels in Edmond that are helping sponsor the tournament. If your team will be spending the night we ask that you give these hotels your patronage. If you need anything please contact the gym supervisor at your location. They are all varsity basketball coaches and will be helpful to you and your team.

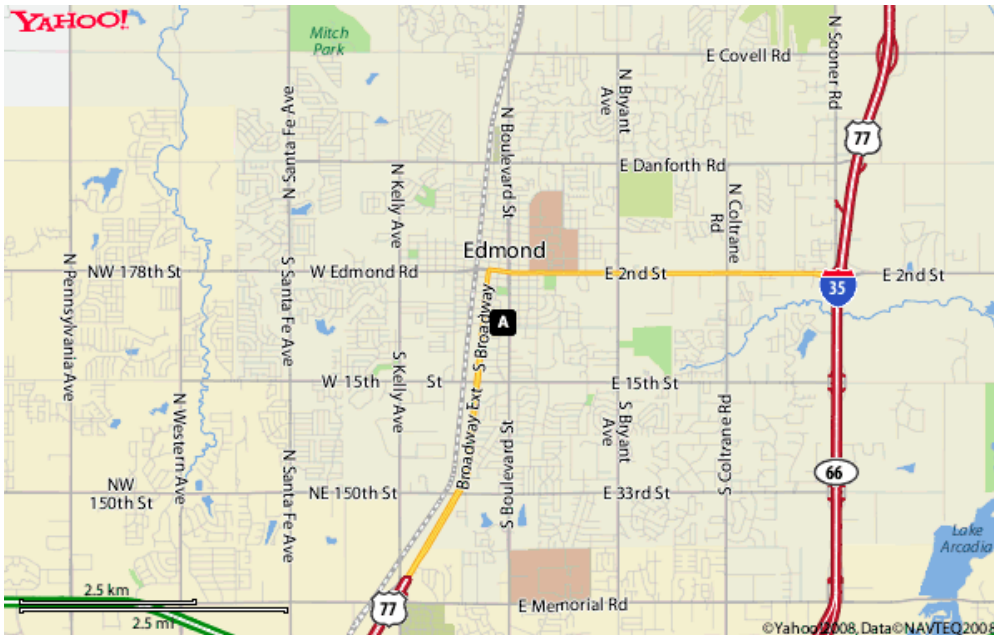
MAYB Summer Tournament Regulations and Guidelines

1. All teams are guaranteed a minimum of 5 scheduled games each weekend. When possible, teams will be ability grouped after pool play and brackets will be played out.
2. Regulation High School Activities Association rules will be followed with the following exceptions:
 - 20 minute running clock except for last 2 minutes of each half, unless one team is ahead by more than 15 points. If lead falls below 15 points, clock will again stop. In addition, clock will stop on all technical fouls, injuries or timeouts (including officials TO). Clock does not restart until it would in a normal dead ball situation.
 - 4th, 5th, and 6th boys will use girls' size ball. 7th grade boys will use the ball size of the state they are playing in.
 - 5-minute halftime and 5 minute pre-game warm-up.
 - Game time is forfeit time.
 - We recommend jerseys with numbers on front and back. No number restrictions exist.
 - 4 timeouts per game, no 30-second timeouts.
3. No locker rooms, balls, etc... will be provided by schools.
4. Individual awards for 1st and 2nd place in each age group.
5. Players may play on only one team within a tournament age group. Player's eligibility will be checked by a current grade card, if requested. Players may play "up" in an older age group. This could mean a player plays in the 8th grade tournament and the 9th-10th grade division. But they can't play on 2 teams in the same 8th grade tournament.
6. Each team is required to provide a scorekeeper or clock operator for each game. We have had great success with this. It is harder to yell at your own person, but please do not put kids in this situation. It is unfair to them if adults are yelling at them!
7. All games will be officiated by High School Certified Officials.
8. No Press Rule: Teams may not full court press if leading by more than 15 points. If the lead drops below 16 points than the no press rule is no longer in affect.
9. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated!!! A referee may remove players from the game or tournament for inappropriate behavior. We are here for the kids. Do not allow or condone poor sportsmanship. This includes coaches and parents!
10. Referee may stop clock with reason. Intentionally wasting time to shorten the game can be punished with a technical foul. This does not mean a team can't use a delay offense at any time they choose. They simply can't tell players to not line up for free throws or sub 1 player at a time to run the clock.
11. Each tournament site will have a director. Please direct questions to this individual during the weekend.
12. No food or drinks allowed in tournament facilities unless otherwise noted.
13. **Tiebreaker procedure is as follows: 1st criteria is overall win/loss record in pool play, 2nd criteria is head to head competition 3rd criteria is point differential (maximum 15 points per game).**
14. **Overtimes will be 2 minutes in length with the clock stopping on all dead balls. There will be a limit of 2 overtimes. If after 2 overtimes have been played and the teams are still tied, a free throw shoot-out will be played. The five players on the court at the end of the second OT will each shoot one free throw, the team with the most free throws made will be the winner of the game. If still tied after the shootout, then a sudden death free throw contest will take place among the same players that participated in the shootout. The coach of each team may decide the order of the players shooting the free throw.**
15. Each tournament will provide two coaches passes per team.
16. In case of foul weather we will attempt to reschedule games if at all possible. This may mean games are shortened or we play late. Refunds and scheduling at later dates are not possible.
17. All roster changes made after the entry deadline should be given to the tournament director before playing a game at a specific tournament. Grade cards will still be used to determine eligibility. You should have these with you at all times in case of protest. Final eligibility rulings will be made by the area director if weekend conflicts occur.
