Directions to Grand Junction and Mesa State College: Grand Junction is located in Western Colorado, approx. 25 miles from the Utah border, along Interstate 70. Mesa State College is located in the heart of the city at:

The attached campus maps will direct you to Saunders Field House (Building 27) at the Maverick Center. Parking is available in lots G1, G2, and G3. We do have a high school wrestling tournament in the building on Saturday, so allow for extra time to find parking.

Admission: The tournament admission schedule is listed below, with daily, weekend, adult, and student passes.

Adult Weekend Pass-\$5.00  
Student Weekend Pass-\$3.00  
Adult Day Pass-\$3.00  
Student Day Pass-\$2.00

Awards: Awards will be given to the top three teams and their players. We also have decided to play out all pools and brackets to give you more than your three game guarantee. All teams will get three games, with most getting four or five games.

Concessions: Concessions will be available on both days and ½ the proceeds from the concession stand will go to the American Cancer Society.

Tournament Packets: Coaches will check in at the MAYB Tournament Headquarters Desk upon arrival to pick up tournament packet with schedule, t-shirts, passes, and other important information. Teams will be given player passes and two coach passes. Players and Coaches must have passes with them at all times to gain access to the facility. All other members of the team party must buy a ticket to enter tournament.

Tournament Schedule: Attached to this email, please make sure you and verify when you play and help us to stay on schedule. Brownson Arena is the main gym where Mesa State plays their games and the Aux Gym is just up the stairs.

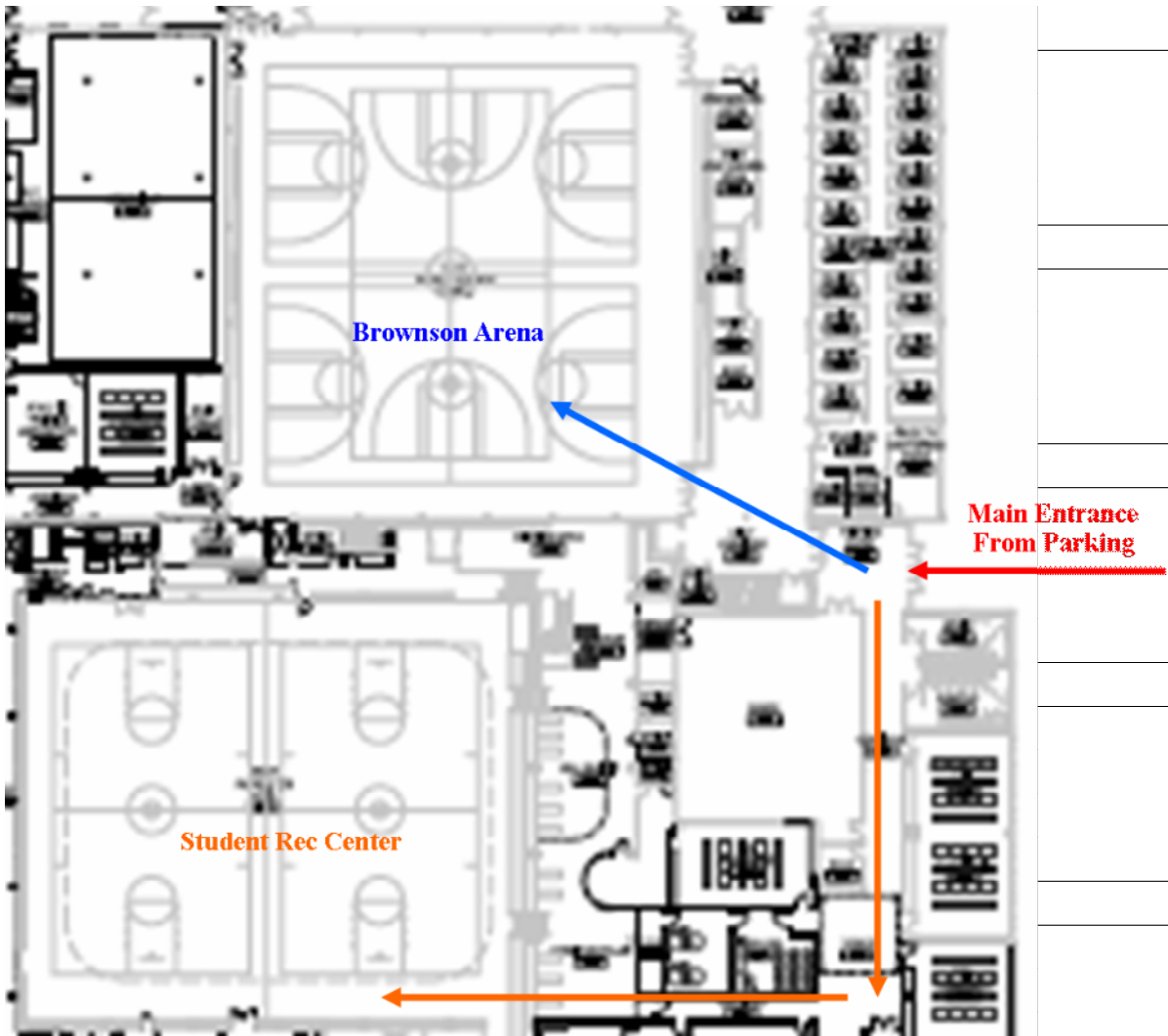
## **Mid America Youth Basketball Summer Tournament Regulations & Guidelines**

1. All teams are guaranteed a minimum of 3 scheduled games. When possible, teams will be ability-grouped after pool play and brackets will be played out.
2. Regulation High School Activities Association rules will be followed with the following exceptions:
  - a. 20 minute running clock except for the last 2 minutes of each half, unless one team is ahead by more than 15 points. In addition, the clock will stop on all technical fouls. Clock does not restart until it would in a normal dead ball situation.
  - b. 4<sup>th</sup>–6<sup>th</sup> boys will use girl's size ball. 7<sup>th</sup> grade boys will use the ball size of the state they are playing in. 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys will use the ball size required by the High School Activities Association of the State that the tournament is in.
  - c. 5-minute half time and 5 minute pre-game warm-up.
  - d. Game time is forfeit time.
  - e. Jerseys need only have a number on the back with no number restrictions.
  - f. 4 time-outs per game, no 20-second time-outs.
  - g. 3/4 Grade teams will play on 8 foot goals, unless otherwise agreed upon by the coaches.
3. No locker rooms, balls & etc...will be provided by the schools.
4. Individual awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each age group.
5. Players may play on only 1 team within a tournament age group. Players eligibility will be checked by a current grade card, if requested. Players may play "up" in an older age group. This could mean a player plays in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament and in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade tournament. But they cannot play on 2 teams in the same 6<sup>th</sup> grade tournament.
6. All games will be officiated by high school certified officials.
7. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated!!! A referee may remove players from the game or tournament for inappropriate behavior. We are here for the kids. Do not allow or condone poor sportsmanship. This includes coaches and parents!!!
8. Referee may stop clock within reason. Intentionally wasting time to shorten the game can be punished by a technical foul. This does not mean a team cannot use a delay offense at anytime they choose.
9. Each tournament site will have a supervisor. Please direct all questions, comments, or concerns to this individual.
10. No food or drinks are allowed in tournament facilities, unless noted otherwise.
11. Tiebreaker procedure is as follows. 1<sup>st</sup> criteria is head to head competition. If a 3 way tie exists and there is no head to head winner, a coin flip will be used to determine seeding. If the tournament is a "Round Robin" tournament, a point differential system will go in effect at the director's discretion. Margin of victory up to a 15-point max per game will be used to determine final placing if there are no brackets.
12. Overtimes will be 2 minutes in length with regular clock operation. The clock stops on all dead balls. 1 additional time-out for each overtime.
13. All roster changes should be made to the National Office in writing at least 48 hours before the start of the tournament. The roster you list in your scorebook for the first game of each tournament is your roster for the weekend. Make sure to include on this list any player who for any reason is not playing the first game, but intends to play following games.

16. Our first and primary goal remains to give all players maximum court time to improve their game in a competitive setting.
