GAMES ARE SCHEDULED ON THE HOUR. We need to keep the games on time for everyone's convenience. Warm-ups and half times will be cut if needed to get the schedules back on time. Please be understanding if this needs to be put into action.

ARRIVE AT GYMS EARLY. Showing up for games late can result in forfeits. We want the games played on the court but if you are not there we have few options. Please call if you have an unforeseen problem occur on the way to gyms. If you do not know where you are going, plan ahead and leave early! Games will start early if we get ahead of schedule. Please plan accordingly.

SCHEDULES CANNOT BE CHANGED. We have tried to meet as many "special requests" as we can.

ALL SPECTATORS AND COACHES MUST SHOW PASSES. When entering a gym, be aware you will have to show your pass to enter. If you lose it, you will be asked to pay again. You will be asked to show it when entering every gym.

OUT OF CONTROL BEHAVIOR WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE TOURNAMENT. There is no excuse for verbally attacking refs, gym directors, other teams, players or anyone! Any punches thrown by players will result in their removal from the tournament. Fans and parents can cause your team to be removed from the tournament.

There are many great teams and players at the tournament. Every team hopes to win. Obviously, that will not happen. Competition can bring out the best and the worst in anyone. Let it be the best instead of the other option during the entire tournament!

Winter Tournament Regulations and Guidelines

1. All teams are guaranteed 3 scheduled games.
2. Regulation High School Activities Association rules will be followed with the following exceptions:
 - 20 minute running clock except for last 2 minutes of the game, **unless one team is ahead by more than 15 points**. If lead falls below 15 points, clock will again stop. In addition, clock will stop on all technical fouls, injuries or timeouts (including officials TO). Clock does not restart until it would in a normal dead ball situation.
 - Teams are not allowed to press over half court with a 20 point or more lead. The first violation will be a warning, if it continues a technical foul may be assessed to the bench if the officials deem it intentional.
 - 28.5 inch basketball will be used in all age groups.
 - 5-minute halftime and 5 minute pre-game warm-up (may be altered if games are running behind).
 - Game time is forfeit time.
 - We recommend jerseys with numbers on front and back. No number restrictions exist.
 - **3** timeouts per game, no 30-second timeouts. **No more than 2 time-outs per half.**
3. No locker rooms, balls, etc... will be provided.
4. Individual awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each age group provided there at 8 teams in the bracket.
5. Players may play on only one team within a tournament age group. Players may play “up” in an older age group. This could mean a player plays in the 7th grade tournament and the 8th grade division. But they can’t play on 2 teams in the same 8th grade tournament.
6. **Each team is required to provide a scorekeeper or clock operator for each game.** We have had great success with this. It is harder to yell at your own person, but please do not put kids in this situation.
7. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated!!! A referee may remove players from the game or tournament for inappropriate behavior. We are here for the kids. Do not allow or condone poor sportsmanship. This includes coaches and parents!
8. Referee may stop clock with reason. Intentionally wasting time to shorten the game can be punished with a technical foul. This does not mean a team can’t use a delay offense at any time they choose. They simply can’t tell players to not line up for free throws or sub 1 player at a time to run the clock.
9. No food or drinks allowed in tournament facilities unless otherwise noted.
10. **Tiebreaker procedure is as follows:** 1st criteria is head to head competition. If a 3-way tie exists in the four team formats and each team has no head to head winner (beat both the other teams) a coin flip is used to determine the winner. Odd team out wins the toss. Then tiebreaker procedure reverts to head to head to determine the other placings. If teams have all not played each other another form may be used.
11. **Overtimes will be 2 minutes in length with regular clock operation.** The clock stops on all dead balls.
12. Each tournament will provide two coaches passes per team.

Directions to the Oskaloosa Gyms

Proceed into Oskaloosa on find Highway 92 (also called A Avenue). This highway runs the entire length of town going east and west.

Take Highway 92, to 3rd Street and head north. At the corner of 3rd street and Highway 92 (A Avenue), there is a gas station which can serve as a landmark. The high schools are located several blocks further down on 3rd Street on your right hand side.

The Middle High School is located at 1704 North Third. It is located on the right hand side of the street. The Spectator gym is in the front of the building. The PE gyms are located down the hall from the Spectator gym.

The Senior High School is located at 1816 North Third. It is also located on the right hand side of the street. Please enter on the South Side and park in the South parking lot. Gym Doors are marked with an outside sign.

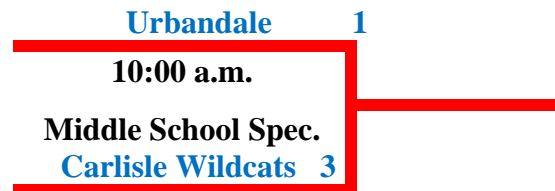
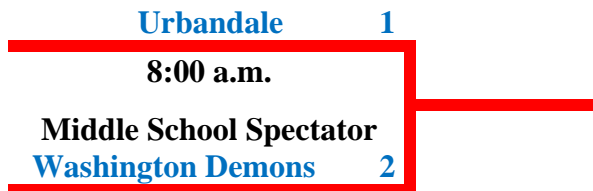

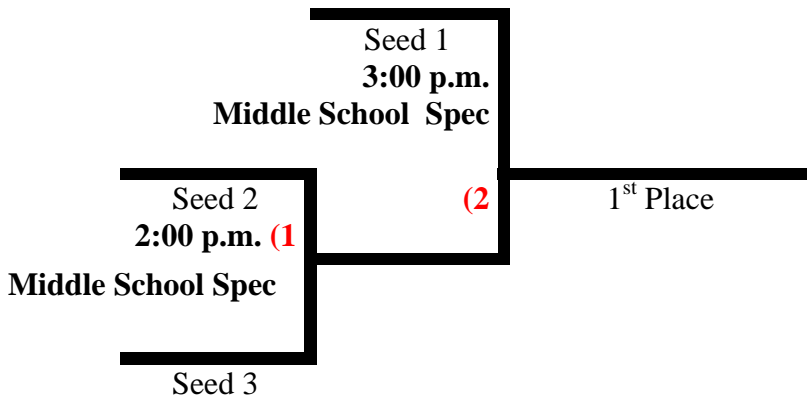

Single Elimination Bracket Play



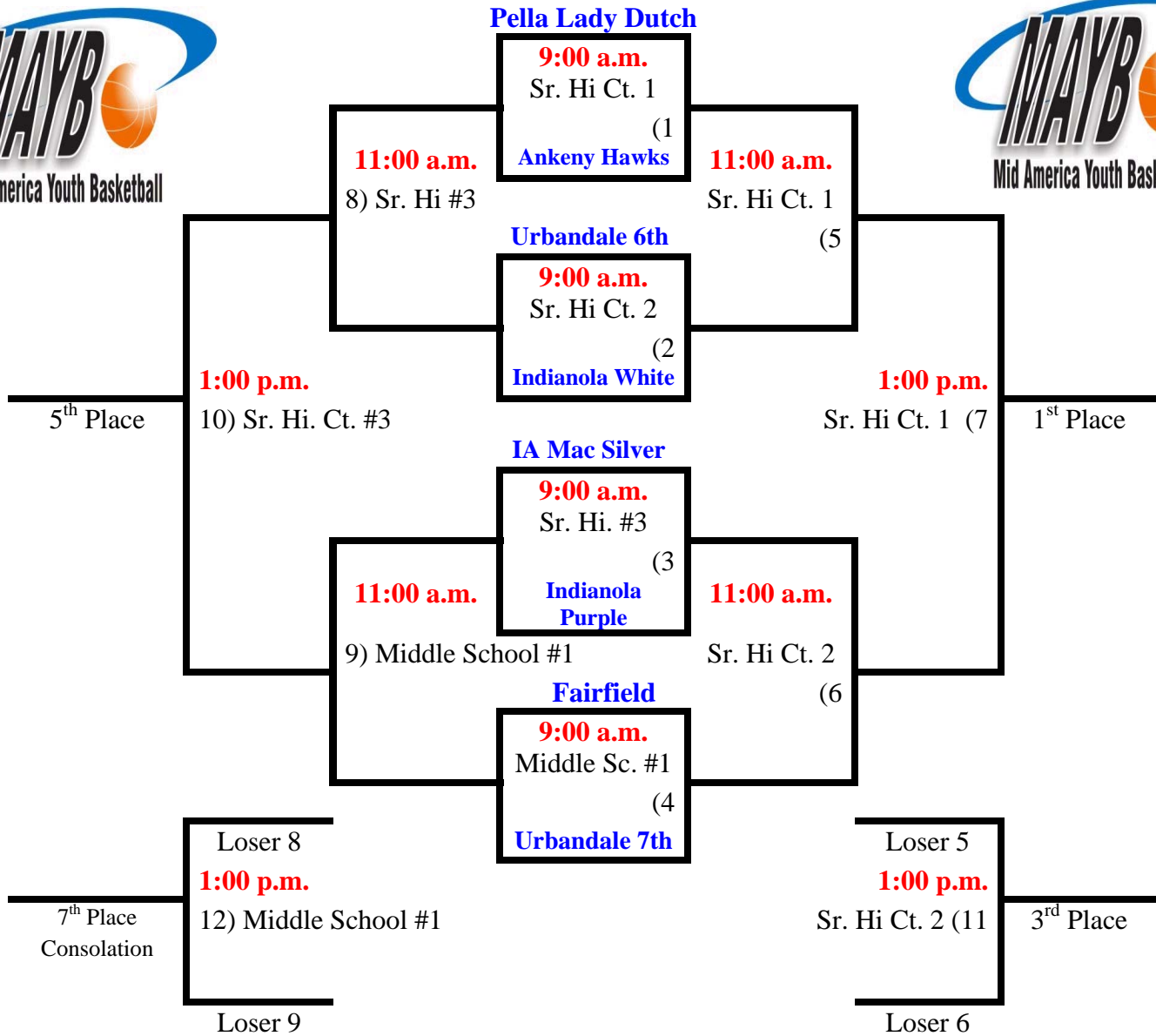
