This single location is the home of 5 full length gyms including an elite high school gymnasium built in 2002. The tournament will officially be named the West KC Tournament.

Reviewing them prior to arrival will help us keep our games on schedule, and will minimize the possibility of confusion during the tournament. Concessions will be provided at all gyms and a full service concession stand with food, drinks, t-shirts, and shorts will be located at the District PE building. No outside food or drinks will be allowed inside any of the facilities (except for water).
