All coaches must check in & confirm roster 30 minutes before your team's first game. Coaches should bring grade cards for their players to each game.

Two coaches per team will be admitted free of charge as long as they have coach's pass.

A coach's pass must be presented upon each entry to the game location

SCOREKEEPING:

Please fill out score sheet (attached or found on score tables) completely before game

Each team needs to provide an **ADULT** score person who should report to the score table **IMMEDIATELY** following the preceding game, only **ONE** person per team at score table

MISCELLANEOUS:

If you are playing the first game of the day **WE ARE NOT ALLOWED** to let anyone in the building until 30 minutes prior to the first game time.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Each team is required to provide an **ADULT** score person. Only one person per team at the score table. Team statisticians must sit on the team bench and not at the score table.

The team listed first on the schedule or on top of bracket is considered the **HOME** team

Home team will wear light colored jerseys, provide game ball, and keep the score clock.

No game will start before the scheduled time unless both coaches agree.

There will be a minimum of 5 minutes warm-up period. Halftime will be 3 minutes long.

The NFHS Rules & Regulations will apply with the following exceptions listed below.

Tournament Rules

Official National Federation High School Association Rules will apply except as noted below.

1. **Coaches Box:** To facilitate the teaching of kids, we will use a large “coaching box.” Coaches may move (out of bounds) from the bench area to half court directly in front of the coach’s team’s bench. A coach may be positive, instruct players and cheer. Coaches may not use this as a license to officiate. The use of this area should be reserved for dead ball situations. Coaches Box is limited to 1 coach at any given time. The coach must sit on the bench after they receive a technical foul.
2. If a player or coach is bleeding or has an open wound, they shall be prohibited from further participation until appropriate treatment has been administered. A clean-up kit will be kept on site to clean up blood should an accident occur. Please see the gym director or concessions stand for the kit should you need it.
3. Grades 2-8 & HS Girls will use size 28.5 school basketballs. High School Boys will use a 29.5 basketball.
4. All Grades will use 10’ goals. All grades will use a 15’ free throw line.
5. Each game will consist of two 20 minute halves with a running clock. The clock will stop on dead balls the final two minutes of each half, provided the score is within 15 points. There will be a 3 minute halftime
6. Overtime will begin with a jump ball. Each Overtime will be 2 minutes in length.
7. Time Outs: Each team will be given four 1 minute time-outs per game.
8. **Defensive Play:** Teams may play any defense at any time during the game. If a team is up by more than 20 points, the leading team must fall back to half court before playing defense.
9. **Team fouls:** Seven team fouls per half. On the 7th team foul and after, free throws will be awarded.
10. A player is disqualified after 5 personal fouls.
11. **No Jewelry** (earrings, necklaces, watches, etc.) These must be removed prior to participation. Players who enter the game with jewelry will receive a technical foul.
12. Each team must field at least 5 players to start a game.
13. All participants must wear non marking tennis shoes.
14. Each team must provide one (1) volunteer per game to complete the following tasks:
Visiting teams will operate the scoreboard. Home teams will keep the scorebook.
15. Players and/or coaches receiving a 2nd (or more) technical (unsportsmanlike) foul in the tournament will be asked to leave the facility, and will be disqualified for the remainder of the tournament.
16. **Tie-Breakers:** Two teams tied—Head to Head result will break the tie. Three teams tied—point differential in the games between the teams that tied (maximum of +15 points or -15 points).
17. **Sportsmanship:** Two direct technical fouls during a game on a player, coach, or team representative will result in their disqualification for the remainder of the tournament. Fighting and/or gross unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification at the sole discretion of the Tournament Director.
