

## Enid Synopsis

The 16<sup>th</sup> annual Enid area tournament is scheduled for July 17-19. Located in the hub of northwest Oklahoma, this end of summer event has continued to be popular for teams preparing for Nationals or wanting to get one last tournament in before the end of the summer season.

Quality officiating, first-class facilities and a vibrant community for activities between games make this event popular and a strong reason to considering entering. In 2013, the Enid Event Center was added to the tournament venues with each team getting to play at least one game in the state-of-the-art facility. Those participating in the tournament will find extremely friendly people, great shopping in downtown Enid, Heritage Hills and Oakwood Mall, over 100 restaurants including more than 50 locally-owned dining establishments, along with an historic downtown square. Other family attractions include the Cherokee Strip Regional Heritage Center – voted Oklahoma’s best new attraction in 2012 – Leonardo’s Children’s Museum and Adventure Quest, a hands on arts and science museum featuring a three-story castle, and the Railroad Museum of Oklahoma with a rail yard filled with engines, dining cars and cabooses that you can walk through and explore.
