We have 11 gyms within ~2 miles of each other so travel between games will be minimal. We will only be using licensed officials and will be giving out team awards for 1st and 2nd and individual awards for 1st-2nd and for 3rd in division with 5 or more teams. Concessions and t-shirts will be available at all locations. Harrison is the perfect choice to headquarter your vacation. Our great location allows you to enjoy all that the area has to offer! From outdoor adventures at the Buffalo River, our many lakes, the White River, or motorcycling our scenic highways to the attractions in Branson and Eureka Springs, Harrison has so much to offer within a very short drive.

TOURNAMENT RULES

All teams are guaranteed and will play a minimum of 3 games. A team trophy will be awarded for 1st. A 2nd place trophy will also be awarded in divisions with 5 or more teams. Individual awards will be given for 1st-2nd place and also 3rd place in divisions with 5 or more teams.

- 2. Each team is required to provide a scorekeeper or a person to run the clock.
- 3. 28.5" ball will be used for all girls teams and for 3rd/4th grade and 5th grade boys.
- 4. Games will consist of 20 minute halves with a running clock except for the last 2 minutes of each half. If a team is up 15 points in the last 2 minutes of the game the clock will run.
- 5. Game time is forfeit time! Each team will be given 5-10 minutes to warm up prior to their game. Half time will be 5 minutes. You should ensure that your team is at the gym 20 minutes prior to your scheduled game time. In the event a game ends early, the next game will start 10 minutes after the conclusion of the preceding game.
- 6. Any player ejected from a game for fighting, overly disrespectful behavior, or unsportsmanlike conduct will be disqualified from the tournament.
- 7. Coaches will be required to have birth certificates/grade confirmation (report cards or other documentation approved by tournament officials) present during all games. Failure to produce this information prior to game will result in the player being ineligible, failure to produce this information once you've played a game or during a game will be an automatic forfeit of that game and any previous games.
- 8. Coaches will be held responsible for the conduct of their players and fans. Unruly fans, coaches and/or players will be removed from the gym and no refunds will be given. Any fan or coach removed from the gym will not be allowed in the gym for his team's next game.

- 9. In the event of a tie at the end of regulation there will be a 2 minute overtime period. Each overtime period will begin with a jump ball and each team will be given 1 additional timeout per overtime.
- 10. Teams listed first in the pools or on top of the brackets will be the home team and wear white.
- 11. The tournament director will make a ruling on any situation not covered in these rules.
- 12. Each team will be given 4 full timeouts per game.
- 13. There will be no outside food or drinks allowed in the gyms. Teams may bring in water bottles, but coolers and water jugs will not be allowed. There will be concessions available at all gyms.
- 14. Admission will be \$5/day for adults and \$3/day for K-12.
- 15. Tiebreakers for seedings will be decided by win/loss record. Secondary is head to head, and the contingent tiebreaker is total points scored.
